

# Celebrate the opening of stage two of the Coastal Pathway

The Christchurch City Council and the Christchurch Coastal Pathway Group invite you to the celebrative opening event for the completion of stage two of the Christchurch Coastal Pathway.

In 2013 the Christchurch Coastal Pathway project was still a pipe dream. Now we have infrastructure for almost half the route already in use.

Contractor Fulton Hogan built the pathway while repairing the earthquake damaged infrastructure and increasing the width of the road: the Main Road three laning project.

The work on the Coastal Pathway is an achievement of true partnership, cooperation and co-investment. Mayor Lianne Dalziel and Councillors Paul Lonsdale and Yani Johanson will be cycling to 'cut' the ribbon and officially open stage two of the pathway.
