

## Works Notice– Seamount Terrace, Mount Pleasant, geotechnical investigations

We are undertaking geotechnical investigations to get a general overview of the geology of the area. These investigations will help inform the design and rebuild of the infrastructure in this area. We aim to commence work on Tuesday 16 October 2012 and continue for approximately one week\*.

### What we are doing

- We will be investigating the ground conditions on Seamount Terrace as shown by the red dots in the figure above.
- The work will commence on Tuesday 16 October 2012. We will be working Monday to Friday intermittently over the course of one week. Work hours are from between 7:00am to 5:30pm.
- You can expect to see a truck with specialised drilling and ground testing equipment at the testing location.
- We expect the work to take about one week to complete, subject to favourable weather and on-site conditions.
- Traffic management will be in place. You can expect to see a coned off area separating the drilling equipment from the traffic. Please be on the lookout for changed traffic conditions and drive to the conditions.
- Provisions will be made for pedestrians to safely walk past the site.

## General information

- The work has no impact on water, power, telecommunications and wastewater services.
- The work may result in increased dust, noise and vibration.
- We will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum. We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your patience while we do this work.
- Safety is our number one priority. Safety is also your responsibility too. Please make sure you stay clear of works, stay alert and keep children and pets at a safe distance.
