

McCormacks Bay Road, Mt Pleasant: Wastewater pressure main installation and the replacement of the western section of the gravity main along McCormacks Bay Road

Progress Update:

Pressure main installation:

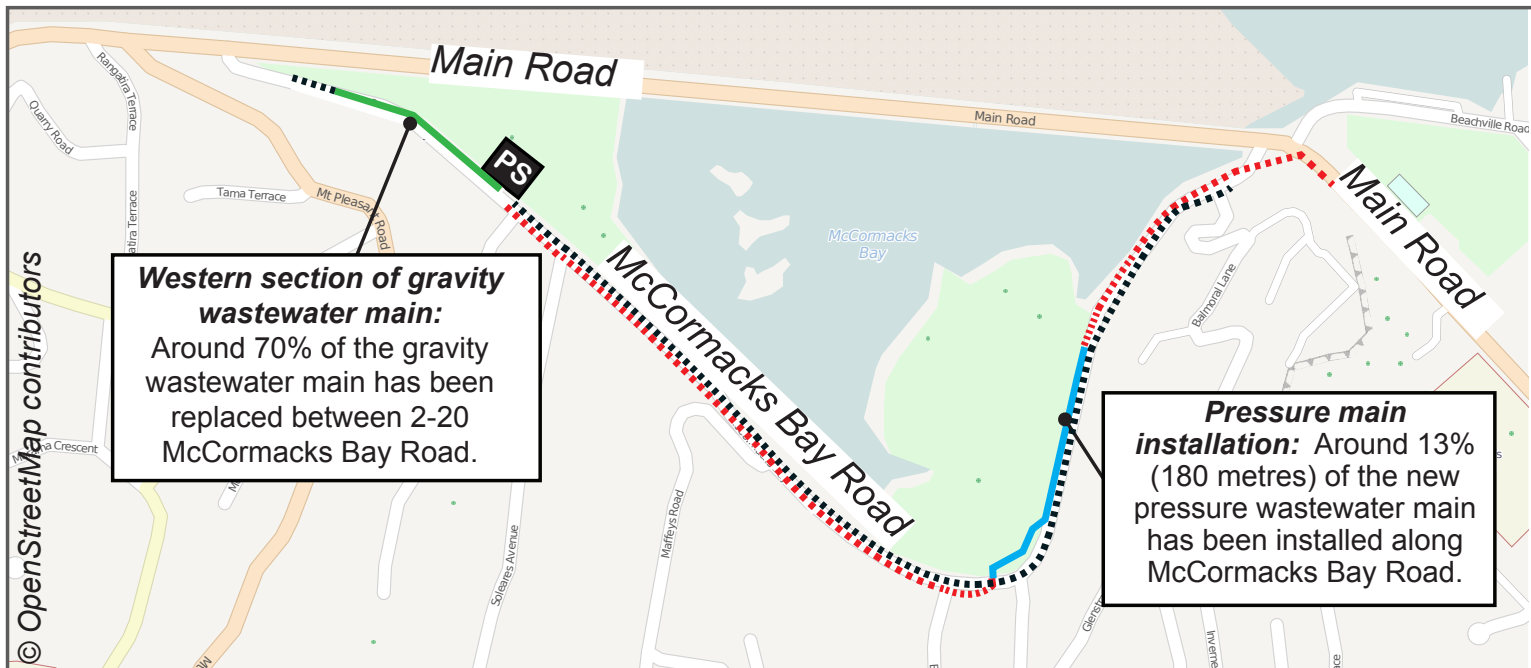
Works have been progressing well despite the weather. Approximately 13% of the new pressure wastewater main has been installed along McCormacks Bay Road. Another crew will begin on McCormacks Bay Road in the coming weeks to help install the pressure main. The new crew will begin by the rugby fields and progress north east. The original crew, working between Basil Place and Glenstrae Road will continue progressing west. Work on the pump station on McCormacks Bay Road will also begin next week.

McCormacks Bay Road pressure main installation 13% complete

Western section of the gravity wastewater main: Around 70% of the gravity wastewater main between 2 - 20 McCormacks Bay Road has been replaced. There is about three days further work to complete the wastewater main, then the house connections (lateral pipes) will be replaced between the property boundary into the new main.

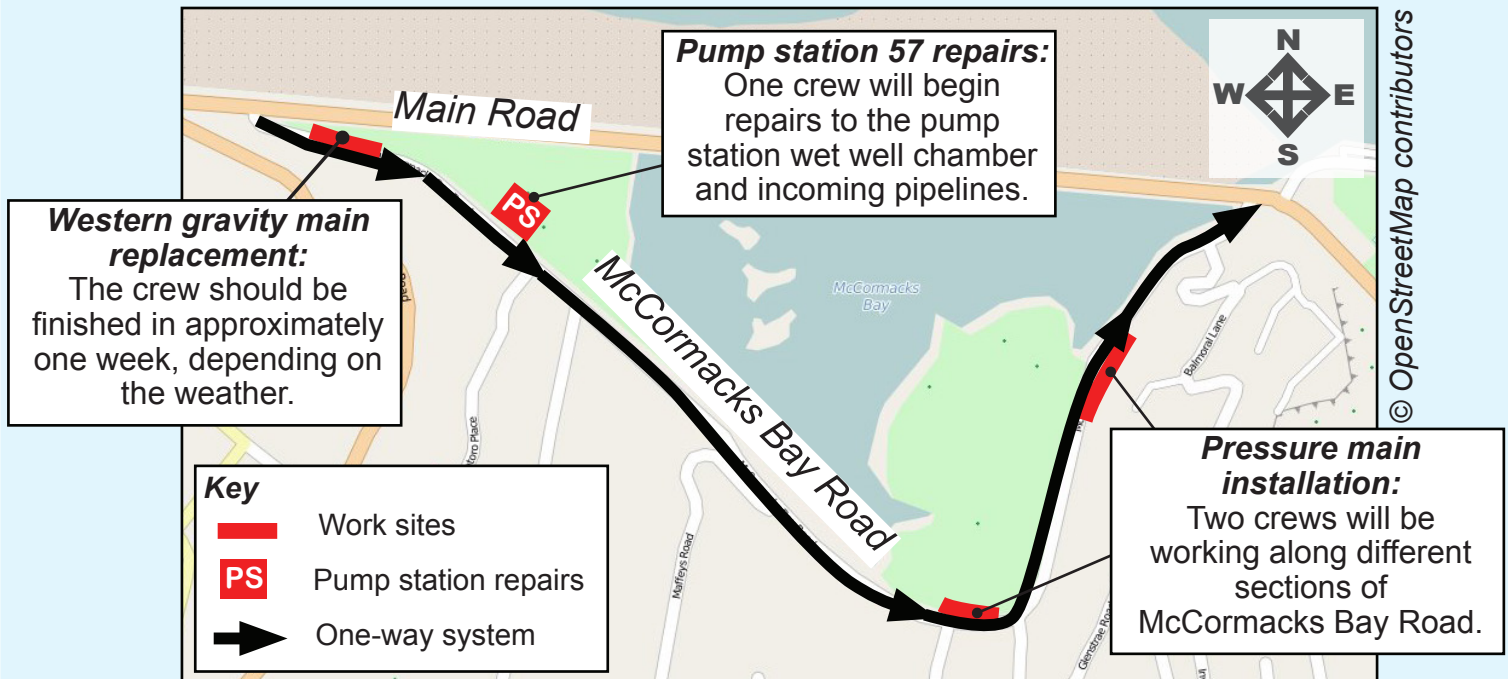
Gravity wastewater from 2 - 20 McCormacks Bay Road 70% complete

Work sites on McCormacks Bay Road:



Traffic management:

- A single traffic lane of McCormacks Bay Road will be closed past the work sites. McCormacks Bay Road will be open to east bound traffic only (towards Redcliffs) past the work sites.
- A detour is in place for west bound traffic via the Main Road causeway.
- There will be no on-street parking immediately adjacent to the worksites. Signage will indicate where parking will not be available.
- There will be a temporary 30km/h speed limit in place through the worksite.
- Access to properties and side streets adjacent to the work site will be maintained via the one-way system on McCormacks Bay Road.

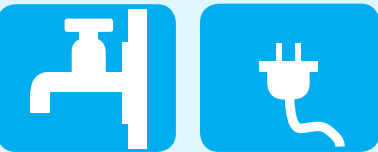

There will be increased noise, dust and vibration levels associated with this work.



Works will have no planned impact on current power, telecommunication, water or gas services. However, the network is still fragile so please be prepared in case there is an unexpected service cut off.



All works are subject to favourable weather and on-site construction conditions.



Safety is our number one priority. Safety is your responsibility too. Stay clear and stay alert - keep children and pets at a safe distance from the work site.



SCIRT's scope of work is to rebuild earthquake-damaged infrastructure to reflect the level of service that existed before the earthquakes. Some roads will be fully rebuilt, others will be partially rebuilt, and many will be patch repaired. Overall, Christchurch's road network will be restored to a similar standard to what existed before the earthquakes.
