2011 Independent Advice Grant	<p>The aim of this grant is to assist homeowners with their ability to make an informed decision on how to proceed with the repair, rebuild, or sale of their earthquake affected property; the purchase of new land and property; the building of a new house; or to obtain an independent property assessment and/or costings for the scope of works to support the decision as to whether the home is economic to repair or needs to be rebuilt. This grant could be used to obtain a geotechnical, engineers or structural report, or obtain information to check against offers received, such as from a builder or from quantity surveyor, or for legal or financial advice.</p> <p>The grant is aimed at assisting vulnerable people whose property has been assessed at costing over \$100,000 to repair and/or their land has been zoned red. A vulnerable person can be defined as the applicant or a member of their household must either be disabled/have a pre-existing medical condition, or be over 65 yrs or have children who live with them who are under 18 yrs. If your grant application is approved then the value is up to a maximum of \$750NZD and shall be paid directly to the contractor upon receipt of their invoice.</p> <p>NB This grant does not pay for retrospective advice or reports and applicants must seek approval for their grant before obtaining advice or reports.</p>
2011 Independent Advice for Small Businesses	<p>Being run through Recover Canterbury, please call 0800 505096 for more details.</p> <p>The aim of this grant is to assist small and family owned and run businesses, with fewer than ten employees, who require financial assistance in order to access professional legal and accounting advice in relation to the effect of earthquakes on their business. This grant is aimed at assisting small businesses and is accessible through Recover Canterbury. If your grant application is approved then the value is up to a maximum of \$750NZD and shall be paid directly to the supplier of the service upon receipt of their invoice.</p>
2011 Targeted (\$124) Moving Grant	<p>The aim of this grant is to assist home owners whose properties have been issued with a Section 124 Building Act Notice by their council. The value of this grant is for \$1,000.</p>
2011 Enhanced Water Filter Grant	<p>The aim of this grant is to assist those people whose domestic water supply comes from either a well or a bore and whose water quality was affected by the earthquake, to the point where they now require an enhanced water filter (EWF), in order to make their water potable. We can only assist where the property owner has already exhausted all other avenues for funding assistance. If your grant application is approved then the value is up to a maximum of \$5,000NZD including GST which shall include the purchase, installation and testing of the EWF.</p>

2011 Building Materials Grant	<p>This grant is for the provision of building materials to home owners, whose land has been zoned green, needing to repair their earthquake damaged homes. The home owner's property must have been uninsured at the time their home was damaged and home owners shall have exhausted all other funding options. The aim is to assist with the purchase of materials for making emergency repairs and weather tightening. The grant is not intended to pay for materials to return the home to its condition before the earthquakes. It is not for work to be done to a cosmetically pleasing standard or on a like-for-like basis.</p>
2011 Bereavement Grant	<p>This application form is for those people who are the immediate family members of a person lost in the February 2011 Christchurch earthquake. An 'immediate family member' includes: the legal guardian of the deceased person's children under 18 years of age, the deceased person's spouse, de-facto partner, parent, sibling, child over 18 years of age or more remote family members in some circumstances.</p> <p>Where an application is approved, the amount of the Bereavement Grant will be \$10,000. Only one application will be considered in relation to each deceased person.</p>
Relocation Grant for Waimakariri & Selwyn	<p>This grant is aimed at assisting those in Waimakariri & Selwyn Districts who will be displaced from their homes while repairs to their land and/or home are made.</p>
