


## Works Notice – St Andrews Hill Road, Mt Pleasant—Retaining wall repair

**What** To repair an earthquake damaged retaining wall on St Andrews Hill Road

**When** Monday 19 May 2014 for about five months

### What we are doing

Downer, as part of the Stronger Christchurch Infrastructure Team (SCIRT) will be repairing a retaining wall on St Andrews Hill Road. The location of the wall is indicated on Map 1 above.

Work is expected to start the week beginning 19 May 2014 and take about five months, **subject to weather and onsite conditions.**

Work to repair the retaining wall:

- Cut down selected trees to allow access to the retaining wall
- Concrete over existing stone
- Anchor the concrete into the road by horizontal drilling
- Reinstate footpath and handrails on St Andrews Hill Road within retaining wall area– refer to Map 1 above.

## Traffic Impacts

Stage 1- two-way traffic and access will be maintained on Main Road and St Andrews Hill Road.

Stage 2 will involve a lane closure on St Andrews Hill Road around the immediate area of the work area. We will notify residents with a works notice prior to this stage of work starting.

## General Impacts

- Resident access to your property will remain in place while work takes place.
- There will be a large number of trees removed within the work site to allow the crew to repair the retaining wall.
- The footpath and bus stop on Main Road will remain open while repair work takes place on the retaining wall.

### General Information:



Please contact Downer on 0800 400 310 if you have any specific access requirements that we need to consider e.g. nurse/ doctor visits, Meals on Wheels, or planned works on your property.



Our standard work hours are Monday to Saturday between the hours of 7.00am to 6.00pm. On rare occasions we may have to work on a Sunday to complete essential work.



There will be increased noise, dust and vibration levels associated with this work.



Works will have no planned impact on current power, telecommunication, water or gas services. However, the network is still fragile so please be prepared in case there is an unexpected service cut off.



All works are subject to favourable weather and on-site construction conditions.



Safety is our number one priority. Safety is your responsibility too. Stay clear and stay alert - keep children and pets at a safe distance from the work site. Keep your vehicle safe by locking it and removing any valuables when your car is parked on the street.

The SCIRT scope of work is to rebuild earthquake-damaged infrastructure to reflect the level of service that existed pre earthquakes. This means most roads throughout the city will be partially repaired or patched rather than fully reconstructed. Full reconstruction will apply only where necessary.
