Road open: Main Road, Mt Pleasant / Redcliffs

The new pressure main from McCormacks Bay Road to Main Road (moa cave) has been installed

From Friday afternoon, 25 July, Main Road will be reopened to traffic again. Thank you for your patience while the pressure main was installed.

This section of Main Road will need to be closed again for up to one week in mid/late August for final testing and commissioning of the pressure wastewater main.

There is still a large amount of work in Mt Pleasant and Redcliffs to repair the earthquake damage pipes and roads. Thank you for bearing with us through the road works, we know it isn't easy.
