## What we are doing:

- As you may be aware, Fletcher (as part of SCIRT) completed infrastructure repairs on Soleares Avenue in 2014.
- Further to this work, in the week beginning Monday 18th July 2016 work will begin to renew a section of the earthquake damaged road surface on Soleares Avenue (between property numbers 24 and 44).
- We anticipate that this work will take about one week to complete.
- Our usual hours of work are 7.00 am to 6.00 pm,
   Monday to Friday, with some weekend and night work when required.
- All work is subject to favorable weather and on-site conditions. With this in mind please be aware timeframes may change.

## **Traffic Impacts**

- Two-way traffic will be maintained on Soleares Avenue by temporary traffic lights.
   Please keep in mind that there may be minor traffic delays on Solares Avenue due to this.
- Please be on the look out for changed traffic conditions and please follow our signs.
- Parking on the street will not be available immediately within the work area.
- At times, footpath access may be disrupted. One side of the street will always be open for pedestrian use. Please follow our signs.

The work may result in increased dust, noise and vibration. We will try to keep any disruption to a minimum and we apologise for any inconvenience.


